Many groups especially some cults teaches that Jesus is not true God but He is a created spiritual being by Father God. One cult teaches that Jesus is angel Michael where as Muslims claims that He is only a prophet of God. We need to be sure what Bible tell us about our beloved saviour.

Supernatural Birth

Mat 1:18 Now the birth of Jesus Christ happened in this way. When his mother Mary was engaged to Joseph, before they lived together she was discovered to be **pregnant by the Holy Spirit.**

He is `God with us'

Prophecy in 700 BC

Isa 7:14 But the LORD will still give you proof. A virgin is pregnant; she will have a son and will name him **Immanuel**.

Fulfillment of prophecy

Mat 1:23 "See, a virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will name him Immanuel," which means, "God (theos)with us."

He is mighty God

Prophecy in 700 BC

Isa 9:6 **A child is born to us!** A son is given to us! And he will be our ruler. He will be called, "Wonderful Counselor," "**Mighty God,**" "Eternal Father," "Prince of Peace."

He is great God

Tit 2:13 as we wait for the
blessed hope and the glorious
appearance of our great God
(theos) and Savior, Jesus Christ.

[-ly, -ward].

He is true God

1Jn 5:20 We also know that the **Son of God** has come and has given us understanding so that we may know the true God. We are in union with the one who is true, his Son Jesus Christ. He is the true God (theos) and eternal life.

He is word and thus God

Joh 1:1-3 In the beginning, the Word existed. The Word was with God (theos), and the Word was God (theos). He existed in the beginning with God. (theos).

He is God over all

Rom 9:5 To them belong the patriarchs, and from them, according to the flesh, **Christ** descended, **who is God (theos) over all**, blessed forever. Amen.

He is eternal God

Heb 1:11 They will come to an end, but you (Jesus) will remain forever. They will all wear out like clothes.

Heb 1:12 You will roll them up like a robe, and they will be changed like clothes. **But you (Jesus) remain the same, and your years will never end."**

Isa 9:6 **A child is born to us!** A son is given to us! And he will be our ruler. He will be called, "Wonderful Counselor," "Mighty God," "Eternal Father," "Prince of Peace."

Heb 1:8 But about the Son he says, "Your throne, O God, (theos) is forever and ever, and the scepter of your kingdom is a righteous scepter.

Jesus is King of Kings and Lord of Lords

Rev 19:16 On his robe and his
thigh he has a name written:
"King of Kings and Lord of
Lords."

Lord, Κύριος, kurios, *koo'-ree-os*

From κῦρος kuros (*supremacy*);
supreme in authority, that is,
(as noun) controller; by
implication Mr. (as a respectful
*title): - **God, Lord, master, Sir.***

He is my God and My Lord too

Joh 20:28 Thomas answered
him, saying "My Lord (kurios)
and my God!" (theos)

Cults teaches that Moses was also called god (Exo 4:16 ,Exo7:1) and we are also called gods in Bible and they says Jesus is also god in that same sense. But we were never called mighty God, eternal God, great God, true God, God over all and Lord of Lords which only belongs to true God.

In the below verse Jesus says what is the difference between Him and us. In John 10, verse 35, Jesus said why we are called gods. We are called gods because we received the word of God and Jesus is the Word. In verse 36 He said what is the difference between us and Him. He said that you are from earth and I am from heaven.

Joh 10:34 Jesus replied to them, "Is it not written in your law, 'I said, "You are gods"'?"

Joh 10:35 If **he (God) called** those to whom the word of God came 'gods' (and the Scripture cannot be set aside),

Joh 10:36 how can you say to the one whom the Father has consecrated and sent into the world, 'You are blaspheming,' because I said, 'I am the Son of God'?

He is the Father

Isa 9:6 **A child is born to us!** A son is given to us! And he will be our ruler. He will be called, "Wonderful Counselor," "Mighty God," **"Eternal Father,"** "Prince of Peace."

Heb 2:13-14 And again, "I will trust him." And again, "I am here with the children God has given me." Therefore, since the children have flesh and blood, he himself also shared the same things, so that by his death he might destroy the one who has the power of death (that is, the devil)

Joh 14:8-9 Philip said to him, "Lord, show us the Father, and that will satisfy us." Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you all this time, Philip, and you still do not know me? The person who has seen me has seen the Father. So how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?"

Joh 10:30 I and the Father are one."

Jesus is worshipped like God

Mat 2:11 After they went into the house and saw the child with his mother Mary, they **fell down and worshiped him**. Then they opened their treasure sacks and **offered him gifts** of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

According to Bible, we are permitted to worship only God and cannot worship even angels or saints. But in Revelation, we can see that Jesus accept the worship but angels refuses worship. These men worshipped only Jesus not even His parents. In the Old Testament, any one receives worship is the appearance of God.

Rev 19:10 I bowed down at his feet to worship him, but he told me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers who hold on to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God,

Rev 22:8-9 I, John, heard and saw these things. When I had heard and seen them, I bowed down to

worship at the feet of the
angel who had been showing
me these things. But he told
me, "Don't do that! I am a
fellow servant with you, your
brothers the prophets, and
those who keep the words in
this book. Worship God!"

Rev 5:8 When the lamb had taken the scroll, the **four living creatures and the twenty-four elders bowed down in front of him**. Each held a harp and a gold bowl full of incense, the prayers of the saints.

In Acts 14, apostles refuses to accept the worship.

Baptizer of Holy Spirit

Mat 3:11 I am baptizing you with water as a token of repentance, but the one who is coming after me is stronger than I am, and I am not worthy to carry his sandals. It is he who will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.

Who can send Holy Spirit except God. Can an angel dare to even think about that? An angel cannot even imagine such a thing.

Son of God

Mat 8:29 Suddenly they screamed, "What do you want with us, **Son of God**? Did you come here to torture us before the proper time?"

demons gives testimony that He is son of God. They never said that Jesus is angel Michael.

Mat 16:16 Simon Peter answered, "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God!"

Disciples gives testimony that He is son of God

Luk 1:35 The angel answered her,
"The Holy Spirit will come over you,
and the power of the Most High
will cover you. Therefore, the child
will be holy and will be called the
Son of God.

An angel gives testimony that He is
son of God.

Mat 3:16-17 When Jesus had been baptized, he immediately came up out of the water. Suddenly the heavens opened up for him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and coming to rest on him. Then a voice from heaven said, "**This is my Son**, whom I love. I am pleased with him!" God gives testimony that He is son of God.

Joh 20:17 Jesus told her, "Don't hold on to me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and tell them, 'I am ascending to **my** Father and **your** Father, to **my** God and **your** God.'"

The above verse proves that there is a difference between our

relation and His relation with God. Even though He is called son of God, He is not a son like us. But He is the only begotten son. (John 3:16). That is why He differentiated between us and Him. We are adopted by God through Jesus. (Rom 8:15)

Jesus forgives sin as God forgives

Mat 1:21 She will give birth to a son, and you are to name him Jesus, because **he** is the one who **will save his people from their sins.**“

Only God can save people from sins. An angel cannot do that. That is why whenever Jesus told that He forgave sins, Jews counted it as blasphemy.

Mat 9:2 All at once some people brought him a paralyzed man lying on a stretcher. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Be courageous, son! **Your sins are forgiven.**"

Jesus can forgive sins because He is incarnation of God.

All things created through Him, by Him

Gen 1:1 In the beginning **God**
created the heavens and the earth.

Joh 1:1-3 In the beginning, the
Word existed. The Word was with
God, and the Word was God. He
existed in the beginning with God.

Through him all things were made, and apart from him nothing was made that has been made.

Jesus was word-word was
God-everything created
through him.

Joh 1:9-11 This was the true light that enlightens every person by his coming into the world. **He was in the world, and the world was made through him.** Yet the world did not recognize him. He came to his own creation, yet his own people did not receive him.

Col 1:15-19 He is the **image of the invisible God**, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things in heaven and on earth were created, things visible and invisible, whether they are kings, lords, rulers, or powers. All things have been created through him and for him.

He himself existed before all things,
and by him all things hold together.

He is also the head of the body,
which is the church. He is the
beginning, the firstborn from the
dead, so that he himself might have
first place in everything. For God
was pleased to have all of his
fullness live in him.

Heb 1:2 has in these last days spoken to us by a Son whom he appointed to be the heir of everything and through whom he also made the universe.

Heb 1:10 And, "In the beginning, Lord, (Jesus) you laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands.

He sustains creation

Col 1:15-19 He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by him all things in heaven and on earth were created, things visible and invisible,

whether they are kings, lords, rulers, or powers. All things have been created through him and for him. He himself existed before all things, **and by him all things hold together.** He is also the head of the body, which is the church. He is the beginning,

Heb 1:3 He is the reflection of God's glory and the exact likeness of his being, and he holds everything together by his powerful word. After he had provided a cleansing from sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Highest Majesty

I am Messiah

Joh 4:25-26 The woman said to him, "I know that the **Messiah** is coming" (who is called Christ).

"When he comes, he will tell us everything." Jesus said to her, "**I am he**, the one who is speaking to you."

Holy Spirit is Spirit of Christ

2Co 3:16-17 But whenever a person turns to the Lord, the veil is removed. Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Lord's Spirit is, there is freedom.

Holy spirit is referred as spirit of Christ in many places.

Gal 4:6 Now because you are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts to cry out, "Abba! Father!"

1Pe 1:11 They tried to find out what era or specific time the **Spirit of Christ in them** kept referring to when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow.

Act 16:7 and when they
were come over against
Mysia, they assayed to go
into Bithynia; and the Spirit
of Jesus suffered them not;

He is the image of God

2Co 4:4 In their case, the god of this world (devil) has blinded the minds of those who do not believe to keep them from seeing the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God.

Php 2:6-8 In God's own form
existed he, And shared with God
equality, Deemed nothing needed
grasping. Instead, poured out in
emptiness, A servant's form did he
possess, A mortal man becoming.
In human form he chose to be,
And lived in all humility, Death on
a cross obeying.

Heb 1:3 He is the reflection of

Jesus is not Angel Michael

One cult teaches that Jesus was angel Michael. Please read what difference is there with Jesus and Angels.

Heb 1:2 has in these last days spoken to us by a Son whom he appointed to be the heir of everything and through whom he also made the universe.

Heb 1:4 and became as much superior to the angels as the name he has inherited is better than theirs.

Heb 1:5 For to which of the angels did God ever say, "You are my Son. Today I have become your Father"? Or again, "I will be his Father, and he will be my Son"?

Heb 1:6 And again, when he brings his firstborn into the world, he says, "Let all God's angels worship him."

Heb 1:7 Now about the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, and his servants flames of fire."

Heb 1:8 But about the Son he says,
"Your throne, O God, is forever
and ever, and the scepter of your
kingdom is a righteous scepter.

Heb 1:9 You have loved
righteousness and hated
wickedness. That is why God, your
God, anointed you rather than
your companions with the oil of
gladness."

Heb 1:10 And, "In the beginning,
Lord, you laid the foundation of the
earth, and the heavens are the
work of your hands.

Heb 1:11 They will come to an end,
but you will remain forever. They
will all wear out like clothes.

Heb 1:12 You will roll them up like a robe, and they will be changed like clothes. **But you remain the same, and your years will never end.** Heb 1:13 But to which of the angels did he ever say, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet"?

Heb 1:14 All of them are spirits on a divine mission, sent to serve those who are about to inherit salvation, aren't they?

Heb 2:15 and might free those who were slaves all their lives because they were terrified by death.

Heb 2:16 For it is clear that he did not come to help angels. No, he came to help Abraham's descendants.

Heb 7:26 We need such a high priest—one who is holy, innocent, pure, set apart from sinners, **exalted above the heavens.**

1Pe 1:20 On the one hand, he was foreknown before the foundation of the world, but on the other hand, he was revealed at the end of time for your sake.

Jesus is at the centre of throne

Rev 7:17 for the lamb in the center of the throne will be their shepherd. He will lead them to springs filled with the water of life, and God will wipe every tear from their eyes."

Where God will sit if Jesus is sitting at the centre of throne? We will also sit with Him one day but we will sit along with Him but not at the centre of throne.

Jesus is the Jehovah

Prophecy in 700 BC

Isa 40:3-5 The voice of one that crieth, Prepare ye in the wilderness the way of **Jehovah**(Jesus in New Testament); make level in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted,

and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the uneven shall be made level, and the rough places a plain: and the glory of Jehovah shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of Jehovah hath spoken it.

Fulfillment of prophecy

Mat 3:3 He was the one the prophet Isaiah was referring to when he said, "He is a voice calling out in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way for **the Lord**(Jesus-Jehovah in Old Testament)! Make his paths straight!'"

In Isaiah, the name Jehovah is used in the prophecy about Jesus. Cults teaches that we have removed the name of Jehovah in new testament and changed it to Lord. But in the above verse, Jesus is called Jehovah as the reference in Isaiah says Jehovah instead of Jesus.

Jesus is the Jehovah

Prophecy in 500 BC

Zec 11:12 And I said unto them, If ye think good, give me my hire; and if not, forbear. So they weighed for my hire thirty *pieces of silver*.

Zec 11:13 And **Jehovah said** unto me, Cast it unto the potter, the goodly

price that I was prized at by them.
And I took the thirty *pieces of silver, and cast them unto the potter, in the house of Jehovah.*

Fulfillment of prophecy

Mat 26:14 Then one of the twelve, who was called Judas Iscariot, went to the high priests

Mat 26:15 and said, "What are you willing to give me if I betray him to you?" They placed before him **thirty pieces of silver,**

Mat 26:16 and from then on he began to look for an opportunity to betray Jesus.

Mat 27:3 Then Judas, who had betrayed him, regretted what had happened when he saw that Jesus was condemned. He brought the thirty pieces of silver back to the high priests and elders,

Mat 27:4 saying, "I have sinned by betraying innocent blood." But they said, "What do we care? See to that yourself."

Mat 27:5 Then he flung the pieces of silver into the sanctuary and went outside. Then he went away and hanged himself.

Mat 27:6 The high priests picked up the pieces of silver and said, "It is not lawful to put this into the temple treasury, because it is blood money."

Mat 27:7 So they decided to use the money to buy the Potter's Field as a burial ground for foreigners.

Mat 27:8 That is why that field has been called the Field of Blood to this day.

• Mat 27:9 Then what had been declared through the prophet Jeremiah was fulfilled when he said, "They took the thirty pieces of silver, the value of the man on whom a price had been set by the Israelites,

Mat 27:10 and they gave them for the potter's field, as the Lord commanded me."

In the prophecy, we can see the Jehovah says that He was priced 30 silver coins and the prophecy fulfilled in Jesus and Judas Iscariot which proves that Jesus is Jehovah himself.

Jesus is the Jehovah

Prophecy in 700 BC

Zec 14:3 Then shall **Jehovah** go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle

Zec 14:4 **And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives,**

which is before Jerusalem on the east; and the mount of Olives shall be cleft in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, *and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.*

Fulfillment of prophecy in future

Act 1:11 They asked, "Men of Galilee, why do you stand looking up toward heaven? **This same Jesus, who has been taken up from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you saw him go up into heaven.**"

Act 1:12 Then returned they unto Jerusalem from the **mount called Olivet**, which is nigh unto Jerusalem, a Sabbath day's journey off.

Prophecy says that Jehovah will come on mount olive but Angels declares that Jesus will return which proves that Jesus is Jehovah

Lord of the Sabbath-Jehovah

Mat 12:8 For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath."

The law of Sabbath is given by Jehovah and only He can do any amendment on the law. But here Jesus declares that He is Jehovah who declared the Sabbath and He has all the authority to change that.

Jesus is called The Lord

Κύριος-kurios-koo'-ree-os,
*(supremacy); supreme in authority,

implication Mr. (as a respectful
title): - God, Lord, master, Sir.*

Jesus was called Lord in new
testament which was also used for
God the Father in Old Testament.
